10. CHAPTER 5, RULE 1: WHETHER PROPER FOR A LAWYER TO DISCLOSE CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION RELEVANT TO CRIME AGAINST LAWYER'S CLIENT

A lawyer asked whether he may disclose any portion of a deceased client's confidential information for the purpose of assisting the police in the investigation of his client's murder.

It was the Committee's view that a lawyer may not release the information unless directed to by the client's personal representative or a court.
