UPON THE APPLICATION of the Petitioner, pursuant to Rules 44 and 45 of the Rules of Court, Section 100 of the *Legal Profession Act*, S.B.C. 1998, c. 25 (the "Act"), and the inherent jurisdiction of the Court, and BY CONSENT.

THIS COURT ORDERS that the Respondent, either personally or through any other entity, shall not engage in the practice of law as defined in Section 1 of the Act, unless and until the Respondent shall become a member in good standing of the Law Society of British Columbia. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Respondent shall not:

- (a) appear as counsel or advocate;




- (b) draw, revise or settle:
 - (i) documents relating to a memorandum or articles under the *Company Act* or minutes, resolutions or other documents relating to the incorporation, registration or organization of a corporate body;
 - (ii) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial;
 - (iii) a will, deed of settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to a probate or letters of administration or the estate of a deceased person;
 - (iv) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia;
 - (iv) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- (c) do any act or negotiate in any way for the settlement of, or settle a claim or demand for damages;
- (d) give legal advice;
- (e) offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (d) above;
- (f) make a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything in paragraphs (a) to (d) above; or

(g) represent that he is a lawyer.

AND THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the parties shall bear their own costs.
