ON THE APPLICATION of the Petitioner without a hearing, **AND BY CONSENT;**

THIS COURT ORDERS that, the Respondent, Elizabeth Foster, until such time as she becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society of British Columbia, be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:

- (a) drawing, revising or settling a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extra-judicial;
- (b) drawing, revising or settling a will, deed of settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to any probate or letters of administration or the estate of a deceased person;

- (c) drawing, revising or settling a document relating in any way to proceedings under a statute of Canada or British Columbia;
- (d) drawing, revising or settling an instrument relating to real or personal estate which is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- (e) giving legal advice; and
- (f) offering to or holding herself out in any way as being qualified or entitled to provide to a person the legal services set out in (a) through (e) above;

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward direct or indirect, from the person for whom the acts are performed;

PROVIDED THAT, should the Respondent Elizabeth Foster become a member of the Society of Notaries Public of British Columbia, nothing herein will prevent the Respondent Elizabeth Foster from providing the legal services a notary public is entitled to provide pursuant to the *Notaries Act*, while she remains a member of the Society of Notaries Public;

PROVIDED FURTHER THAT the Respondent Elizabeth Foster will not be in breach of this Order if she is employed by a practising lawyer, a law firm, a law corporation, or the government, and acts under the supervision of a practising lawyer.
