ON THE APPLICATION of the Petitioner without a hearing, AND BY CONSENT:

THIS COURT ORDERS that the Respondent, Dawn Lagerbom, until such time as she becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society of British Columbia, be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:

- (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
- (b) drawing, revising or settling a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extra-judicial;
- (c) drawing, revising or settling a document relating in any way to proceedings under a statute of Canada or British Columbia;

- (d) giving legal advice; and
- (e) offering to or holding herself out in any way as being qualified or entitled to provide to a person the legal services set out in (a) through (d) above;

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward direct or indirect, from the person from whom the acts are performed **PROVIDED THAT** the Respondent may provide services which are the lawful practice of a notary public; and

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS THAT the Petitioner be awarded its costs fixed at \$1000.


