THIS COURT ORDERS that the Respondent, Gilbert Beaudry, until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society of British Columbia, and the Respondent Dominion Tax Accountants and Company, Incorporated, be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:


- (a) drawing, revising or settling a petition, memorandum, notice of articles or articles under the *Business Corporations Act*, or an application, statement, affidavit, minute, resolution, bylaw or other document relating to the incorporation, registration, organization, reorganization, dissolution or winding up of a corporate body;
- (b) giving legal advice; and
- (c) offering to or holding themselves out in any way as being qualified or entitled to provide to a person the legal services set out in (a) and (b) above;


