THE PETITION of the Petitioner, The Law Society of British Columbia, coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia, on the 29th, 30th and 31st day of May, 2006, and on reading the Petition and Affidavits filed herein, and on hearing Carmel Wiseman, Counsel for the Petitioner, and the Respondent, R. Charles Bryfogle, appearing on his own behalf; and judgment being reserved to this date:

THIS COURT ORDERS that the Respondent, R. Charles Bryfogle, until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society of British Columbia, be prohibited and enjoined from:

- (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
- (b) drawing, revising or settling a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extra-judicial;

- (c) drawing, revising or settling a will, deed of settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to a probate or letters of administration or the estate of a deceased person;
- (d) drawing, revising or settling a document relating in any way to proceedings under a statute of Canada or British Columbia;
- (e) doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
- (f) giving legal advice;
- (g) offering to or holding himself out in any way as being qualified or entitled to provide to a person the legal services set out in (a) through (f) above;

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect, from the person for whom the acts are performed;

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Respondent be prohibited and enjoined from commencing, prosecuting or defending a proceeding in any court in his own name or in the name of another person, without leave of the court, other than representing himself as an individual party to a proceeding acting without counsel solely on his own behalf;

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Respondent be prohibited and enjoined from acting as attorney or advocate on behalf of any party pursuant to the *Court Agent Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996 c. 76;


THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Respondent be required to inform General Counsel of the Law Society of any proceeding or legal matter in which he is involved in any manner whatsoever, other than representing himself as an individual party to a proceeding acting without counsel solely on his own behalf;

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the ~~consent~~ of the Respondent as to the form of the Order be dispensed with; and

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS AND BY CONSENT that the Petitioner be awarded its costs fixed in the amount of \$2,000.00.
