- (f) giving legal advice; and
- (g) offering to or holding herself out in any way as being qualified or entitled to provide to a person the legal services set out in (a) through (f) above;

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward direct or indirect, from the person from whom the acts are performed; and

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Petitioner be awarded its costs.
