THE APPLICATION of the Petitioner, coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia on Wednesday, the 5th day of December, 2007, and on hearing Robert W. Cooper and Joelle Walker, counsel for the Petitioner, and the Respondent Mohammed B. Wanli, acting on his own behalf:

THIS COURT ORDERS that

- the Respondent Mohammed B. Wanli be found in contempt of Court, for his wilful disobedience of the Order of the Honourable Chief Justice pronounced November 15, 2000 which restrained and prohibited him from, among other things, drawing, revising or settling a document for use in a proceeding judicial or extra judicial, which terms he has wilfully

disobeyed by preparing for a fee a Writ of Summons, Statement of Claim, and other ancillary documents on behalf of William J. Mondy in divorce proceedings commenced in the Vancouver Registry of the Supreme Court of British Columbia under Action No. E040566;

2. the Respondent Mohammed B. Wanli be fined \$7,500.00 for his contempt;
3. the fine of \$7,500.00 shall be paid to William J. Mondy;
4. the Respondent Mohammed B. Wanli shall pay to the Petitioner the costs of these contempt proceedings on Scale B; and
5. approval of the form and content of this Order by the Respondent Mohammed B. Wanli be dispensed with.
