- (c) drawing, revising or settling a document relating in any way to proceedings under a statute of Canada or British Columbia;
- (d) agreeing to place at the disposal of another person the services of a lawyer;

- (e) doing any act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling a claim or demand for damages;
- (f) giving legal advice; and
- (g) offering to or holding himself out in any way as being qualified or entitled to provide to a person the legal services set out in (a) through (f) above;

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward direct or indirect, from the person for whom the acts are performed; and

**THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS THAT** the Petitioner be awarded its costs.
