ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia, dated 26 July 2013 without notice coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia on 18 October 2013 and on hearing Michael Kleisinger, counsel for the petitioner;

## THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Respondent, Michael Helfrich a.k.a. Marvin Helfrich, until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
  - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
  - (b) drawing, revising or settling

- (i) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial;
- (ii) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia; or
- (iii) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
- (d) giving legal advice;
- (e) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) through (d); and
- (f) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) through (d).
- 2. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mr. Helfrich be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
  - falsely representing himself as being a lawyer or in any other way that connotes that he is qualified or entitled to engage in the practice of law; and
  - commencing, prosecuting or defending a proceeding in any court, except as an individual party to a proceeding acting without counsel and on his own behalf.

The Law Society be awarded its costs in the amount of \$2,500 represents, totalines 2,864.

Mr. Helfrich will be deemed personally served with this order on the date.
