A JUDGE OF THE COURT

ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia (the "Law Society"), dated August 1, 2013, without a hearing and by consent, and on reading the materials filed by Michael Kleisinger, counsel for the petitioner:

THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. The respondent, Eduardo R. Pereira, until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
 - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
 - (b) drawing, revising or settling
 - i. a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial, and


- ii. a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia,
- (c) doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
- (d) giving legal advice;
- (e) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) through (d); and
- (f) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) through (d)

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect, from the person for whom the acts are performed unless performing those acts under the direct supervision and employment of a practicing lawyer.


2. Mr. Pereira, until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
 - i. commencing, prosecuting or defending a proceeding in any court other than representing himself as an individual party to a proceeding acting without counsel solely on his own behalf; and
 - ii. falsely representing himself as being a lawyer or otherwise qualified or entitled to engage in the practice of law.
3. On or before November 1, 2013, Mr. Pereira will pay \$2,000 to the Law Society representing its costs.
4. On or before November 1, 2013, Mr. Pereira will pay restitution in the amount of \$200 to the Law Society, in trust, for Aida Pascual.

5. All payments under this order will be made by certified cheque, money order, bank draft or trust cheque from Mr. Pereira's lawyer.
