CONSENT ORDER

BEFORE A JUDGE OF THE COURT

23 JANUARY 2015

ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia (the "Law Society"), without a hearing and by consent:

THIS COURT ORDERS that:

- Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, the respondent, Boguslaw Bejm, is permanently prohibited and enjoined from
 - (a) drawing, revising or settling a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extra-judicial;
 - drawing, revising or settling a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia;
 - doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
 - (d) giving legal advice:

- (e) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (d); and
- (f) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (d)

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward direct or indirect, from the person for whom the acts are performed.

2. The parties will bear their own costs.
