CONSENT ORDER

BEFORE) A JUDGE OF THE COURT) November 25, 2015

ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia (the "Law Society"), without a hearing and by consent:

THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:

- Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Brent Chow doing business as Core Legal Services, Core Finance and Taxation, Core Accounting and 'www.coretaxation.com' ("Mr. Chow"), be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
 - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
 - (b) drawing, revising or settling
 - (i) a petition, memorandum, notice of articles or articles under the Business Corporations Act, or an application, statement, affidavit, minute, resolution, bylaw or other document relating to the incorporation, registration, organization, reorganization, dissolution or winding up or a corporate body,
 - (ii) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial,
 - (iii) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia, and

- (iv) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- (c) doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
- (d) giving legal advice;
- making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) (e) to (d);
- (f) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (d)

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect, from the person for whom the acts are performed.

- 2. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mr. Chow be permanently prohibited and enjoined from commencing, prosecuting or defending a proceeding in any court, except when representing himself as an individual party to a proceeding, acting without counsel, solely on his own behalf.
- 3. On or before November 2, 2015, Mr. Chow shall pay the Law Society \$1,500 representing its costs.
