ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia (the "Law Society"), without a hearing and by consent:

THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, John Rynd also known as John Schneider ("Mr. Rynd") shall be permanently prohibited and enjoined from engaging in the practice of law in the Province of British Columbia, including:
 - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
 - (b) drawing, revising or settling
 - (i) a petition, memorandum, notice of articles or articles under the *Business Corporations Act*, or an application, statement, affidavit, minute, resolution, bylaw or other document relating to the incorporation, registration, organization, reorganization, dissolution or winding up or a corporate body,

- (ii) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial,
 - (iii) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia, and
 - (iv) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- (c) doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
 - (d) agreeing to place at the disposal of another person the services of a lawyer;
 - (e) giving legal advice;
 - (f) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e);
 - (g) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e); and
 - (h) commencing, prosecuting or defending a proceeding in any court, except when representing himself as an individual party to a proceeding, acting without counsel, solely on his own behalf;

regardless of whether he performs any of those acts for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect from the person for whom the acts are performed.

2. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mr. Rynd shall be permanently prohibited and enjoined from representing himself as a lawyer, counsel, or in any other manner that connotes that he is qualified or entitled to engage in the practice of law in the Province of British Columbia.
3. This order applies to Mr. Rynd acting in his personal capacity and to any business or company that he owns or operates.
4. Notwithstanding the prohibitions in this order, Mr. Rynd may represent himself as an individual party to a proceeding acting without counsel, solely on his own behalf.


- 5. The parties are at liberty to seek further directions or orders from the Court with respect to the terms of this Order.
