ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia (the "Law Society"), dated 20 September 2016, coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia, on 17 November 2016, and on hearing Michael J. Kleisinger, lawyer for the Law Society, and from reading the materials filed herein, and with no one appearing on behalf of the respondent, Charles David Parent a.k.a. Charles Parent-Quinn a.k.a. Chase Parent-Quinn ("Mr. Parent"), although having been duly served with the petition to the court dated 20 September 2016, and having failed to file and serve a response to petition within the time required, and with judgment being reserved to this date:

## THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mr. Parent is permanently prohibited and enjoined from engaging in the practice of law as defined in the Legal Profession Act, S.B.C. 1998, c. 9, s. 1, including:
  - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
  - (b) drawing, revising or settling

- (i) a petition, memorandum, notice of articles or articles under the *Business Corporations Act*, or an application, statement, affidavit, minute, resolution, bylaw or other document relating to the incorporation, registration, organization, reorganization, dissolution or winding up of a corporate body,
- (ii) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial,
- (iii) a will, deed or settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to a probate or a grant of administration or the estate of a deceased person,
- (iv) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia, or
- (v) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office,
- doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages,
- (d) agreeing to place at the disposal of another person the services of a lawyer,
- (e) giving legal advice,
- (f) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e), and
- (g) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e),

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect from the person for whom the acts are performed.

- 2. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mr. Parent is permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
  - commencing, prosecuting or defending a proceeding in any court, except when representing himself as an individual party to a proceeding, acting without counsel, solely on his own behalf; and
  - b. representing himself as a lawyer, attorney, counsel, a member of the Law Society or in any other manner that connotes that he is qualified or entitled to engage in the practice of law.

3. The Law Society is awarded its costs fixed at \$3500.
