ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia (the "Law Society"), dated 22 February 2017, coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia, on 27 April 2017, and on hearing Michael J. Kleisinger, lawyer for the Law Society, and from reading the materials filed herein, and with no one appearing on behalf of the respondent, Vivian Pei-Hua Chiang, although having been duly served with the petition to the court dated 22 February 2017 and supporting materials, and having failed to file and serve a response to petition within the time required:

THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. Until such time as she becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Vivian Pei-Hua Chiang shall be permanently prohibited and enjoined from engaging in the practice of law as defined in section 1 of the *Legal Profession Act*, SBC 1998, c. 9, including:

- (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
- (b) drawing, revising or settling

- (i) a petition, memorandum, notice of articles or articles under the *Business Corporations Act*, or an application, statement, affidavit, minute, resolution, bylaw or other document relating to the incorporation, registration, organization, reorganization, dissolution or winding up of a corporate body,
 - (ii) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial,
 - (iii) a will, deed or settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to a probate or a grant of administration or the estate of a deceased person,
 - (iv) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia, or
 - (v) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- (c) doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
 - (d) agreeing to place at the disposal of another person the services of a lawyer;
 - (e) giving legal advice;
 - (f) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e); and
 - (g) making a representation that she is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e)

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect from the person for whom the acts are performed.

2. Until such time as she becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Ms. Chiang shall be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
 - a. representing that she is a lawyer, solicitor, counsel, member of the Law Society, or in any other manner that connotes she is qualified or entitled to engage in the practice of law; and
 - b. commencing, prosecuting or defending a proceeding in any court, except if representing herself as an individual party to a proceeding, acting without counsel, solely on her own behalf.

3. The Law Society is awarded its costs fixed at \$1,500.
