ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia (the "Law Society"), dated 6 October 2016, coming on for hearing at Kelowna, British Columbia, on 8 March 2017, and on hearing Michael J. Kleisinger, lawyer for the Law Society, and Kazimierz Chester Crischuk also known as Kaz Crischuk, Kaz-Chester: Crischuk, Kazimierz-Czelaw: Crischuk and Mythlim-Axkw ("Mr. Crischuk"), appearing on his own behalf;

THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mr. Crischuk is permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
 - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
 - (b) drawing, revising or settling
 - (i) a petition, memorandum, notice of articles or articles under the *Business Corporations Act*, or an application, statement, affidavit, minute, resolution, bylaw or other document relating to the incorporation, registration, organization, re-

organization, dissolution or winding up of a corporate body,

- (ii) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial,
 - (iii) a will, deed or settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to a probate or a grant of administration or the estate of a deceased person,
 - (iv) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia, or
 - (v) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- (c) doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
 - (d) agreeing to place at the disposal of another person the services of a lawyer;
 - (e) giving legal advice;
 - (f) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e); and
 - (g) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e);

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect from the person for whom the acts are performed.

2. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mr. Crischuk is permanently prohibited and enjoined from commencing, prosecuting or defending a proceeding in any court, except when representing himself as an individual party to a proceeding, acting without counsel, solely on his own behalf.

3. The Law Society is awarded its costs fixed at \$2,600.
4. Mr. Crischuk need not approve the form of this Order.
