## ORDER MADE AFTER APPLICATION

ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, the Law Society of British Columbia (the "Law Society"), coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia, on 31 July 2018, and on hearing Michael J. Kleisinger, lawyer for the Law Society, and with no one appearing on behalf of the respondents, Joseph Alain Theriault and Trojan Roofing & Exteriors Ltd. ("Trojan"), who, although duly served, failed to file any response to petition:

## THIS COURT ORDERS that:

- 1. Until such time as Joseph Alain Theriault becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, both Mr. Theriault and Trojan are permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
  - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
  - (b) drawing, revising or settling:
    - (i) a petition, memorandum, notice of articles or articles under the *Business Corporations Act*, or an application, statement, affidavit, minute, resolution, bylaw or other document relating to the incorporation, registration,

- organization, reorganization, dissolution or winding up of a corporate body,
- (ii) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial,
- (iii) a will, deed of settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to a probate or a grant of administration or the estate of a deceased person,
- (iv) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia, or
- (v) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- (c) doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
- (d) agreeing to place at the disposal of another person the services of a lawyer;
- (e) giving legal advice;
- (f) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e); and
- (g) making a representation that they are qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e)

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect from the person for whom the acts are performed.

- 2. Until such time as Mr. Theriault becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mr. Theriault and Trojan are permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
  - a) representing themselves as being lawyers or using any other title that connotes they are qualified or entitled to engage in the practice of law; and
  - b) commencing, prosecuting, or defending a proceeding in any court, except if representing themselves as individual parties to a proceeding, acting without counsel, solely on their own behalf.

3. The Law Society is awarded its costs fixed at #3,409.16.
