THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. Until he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Mar Dolar and Global Fingerprinting Services Canada Ltd., and each of them, are permanently prohibited and enjoined from engaging in the practice of law as defined in section 1 of the *Legal Profession Act*, S.B.C. 1998, c. 9, including:
 - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
 - (b) drawing, revising or settling
 - (i) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial; or
 - (ii) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia;
 - (c) giving legal advice;

- (d) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (c); and
- (e) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (c)


for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect from the person for whom the acts are performed.
