ON THE APPLICATION of the petitioner, coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia on January 26, 2021, by telephone, and on hearing Gavin Hoekstra, lawyer for the petitioner, and no one appearing on behalf of the respondent, Daniel Lozinik, although duly served;

THIS COURT ORDERS that:

- 1. Until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Daniel Lozinik is prohibited and enjoined from engaging in the practice of law as defined in section 1 of the *Legal Profession Act*, S.B.C. 1998, c. 9, including:
 - (a) appearing as counsel or advocate,
 - (b) drawing, revising or settling
 - (i) a petition, memorandum, notice of articles or articles under the *Business Corporations Act*, or an application, statement, affidavit, minute, resolution, bylaw or other document relating to the incorporation, registration, organization, reorganization, dissolution or winding up or a corporate body,
 - (ii) a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extrajudicial,

- (iii) a will, deed of settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to a probate or a grant of administration or the estate of a deceased person,
- (iv) a document relating in any way to a proceeding under a statute of Canada or British Columbia, and
- (v) an instrument relating to real or personal estate that is intended, permitted or required to be registered, recorded or filed in a registry or other public office;
- (c) doing an act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
- (d) agreeing to place at the disposal of another person the services of a lawyer;
- (e) giving legal advice;
- (f) making an offer to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e); and
- (g) making a representation that he is qualified or entitled to do anything referred to in paragraphs (a) to (e)

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward, direct or indirect, from the person for whom the acts are performed.

- 2. Until he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society, Daniel Lozinik is permanently prohibited and enjoined from representing himself or any entity that he controls as being a lawyer, a law firm, a law corporation, or any other title that connotes that he is entitled or qualified to engage in the practice law.
- 3. The Law Society may serve the respondent, Daniel Lozinik with a copy of this order, once entered, by:
 - (a) emailing a copy to "admin@angeliclaw.com" and
 - (b) sending a copy by registered mail to #1058, 240 70 Shawville Blvd., Calgary, Alberta, V2Y 2Z3.
- 4. Daniel Lozinik shall be deemed personally served with this order on the date that is 7 days after the Law Society sends the order in the manner described in paragraph 3(a) and (b).

5. Daniel Lozinik must pay lump sum costs to the Law Society in the amount of \$1,500.
