ON THE APPLICATION of the Petitioner, without a hearing, and on reading the Petition and Affidavits of Ellen B. Gerber sworn May 1, 2007, Robert S. Abrams sworn May 18, 2007, and Anna Lin sworn May 29, 2007, filed herein;

THIS COURT ORDERS THAT the Respondent, Robert Arthur Menard, until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society of British Columbia, be permanently prohibited and enjoined from:

- (a) appearing as counsel or advocate;
- (b) drawing, revising or settling a document for use in a proceeding, judicial or extra-judicial;
- (c) drawing, revising or settling a will, deed of settlement, trust deed, power of attorney or a document relating to a probate or letters of administration or the estate of a deceased person;
- (d) drawing, revising or settling a document relating in any way to proceedings under a statute of Canada or British Columbia;

- (e) doing any act or negotiating in any way for the settlement of, or settling, a claim or demand for damages;
- (f) agreeing to place at the disposal of another person the services of a lawyer;
- (g) giving legal advice;
- (h) offering to or holding himself out in any way as being qualified or entitled to provide to a person the legal services set out in (a) through (g) above;

for or in the expectation of a fee, gain or reward direct or indirect, from the person for whom the acts are performed;

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS THAT the Respondent, Robert Arthur Menard, until such time as he becomes a member in good standing of the Law Society of British Columbia, be permanently prohibited and enjoined from holding himself out as a lawyer or identifying himself in any way that suggests he is a lawyer.

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS THAT the Petitioner be awarded its costs.
