 - (b) agrees to consult the Principal diligently and faithfully, and to observe strictly all confidences of the Principal or of others in the Principal's office.
3. The Principal and the Student agree to indemnify each other for any damage, injury or loss which one of them may suffer through the other's breach of this agreement.
