## **Summary**

Mr. Beirne failed to file an appeal of a criminal conviction on behalf of a client after being instructed to do so. The discipline hearing panel ordered that he be reprimanded and pay a \$2,000 fine.

## **Facts**

In 1993 Mr. Beirne was retained by Mr. C, who had been convicted of second degree murder, to file an appeal of the conviction. Mr. Beirne met once with Mr. C but had no further contact with him and did not file an appeal. Mr. C retained other counsel in 1996.

## **Decision**

Mr. Beirne admitted, and the hearing panel found, that his conduct constituted professional misconduct.

## **Penalty**

After hearing submissions from counsel for the Law Society and for the respondent, and after considering evidence given on mitigation of penalty, the panel ordered that Mr. Beirne:

- 1. be reprimanded; and
- 2. pay a \$2,000 fine by February 3, 2001.
