Failing to Reply Promptly to Law Society Correspondence

The Law Society wrote to the member on May 19, June 8 and July 21, 1987 concerning the member's failure to pay the penalty for the late filing of his Form N Accountant's Report. The member sent in a letter of response to the Society and commenced payment with respect to the late filing penalty after being informed in October, 1987 that a citation had been authorized against him.

The member admitted that his conduct, in failing unreasonably to reply promptly to Law Society correspondence, constituted professional misconduct pursuant to Ruling F(1) of the *Professional Conduct Handbook*.
