

Failing to Respond to Law Society Correspondence

The Law Society wrote to the member on March 5, 1985 on a matter requiring his explanation. A reminder letter was sent to the member on March 19. The member delivered a letter of response to the Society on June 24, after being informed that a citation had been authorized against him.

The member admitted that his conduct in failing unreasonably to reply promptly to Law Society correspondence constituted professional misconduct pursuant to Ruling F(1) of the *Professional Conduct Handbook*.
