Endorsement on Professional Conduct Record

## NIVES EMILIA ITALIA JADRESKO

(Vancouver) Called to the Bar: July 13, 1982

The member was engaged by G to collect a debt owned to him by the complaint's clients, N and H, for his services as a promoter.

On December 13, 1983 the member wrote to the complainant solicitor, requesting payment of \$11,571.63. In her letter the member stated:

Should this sum not be received by this office on or before Monday, December 02, 2002 19, 1983, I have instructions to file an official complaint with the Superintendent of Brokers. In addition to breaches under the Securities At there are also possible criminal offences which my client has instructed me that he intends to pursue should this matter not be settled forthwith.

The member admitted that her conduct in writing the paragraph quoted above constituted a violation of Ruling E5 of the *Professional Conduct Handbook* which reads:

... No member shall demand or appear to demand on behalf of a client a payment of money or any other thing from any person to avoid a prosecution being launched against that person.
