The Law Society wrote to the member on August 6, 1985 on a matter requiring his explanation. Reminder letters were sent on August 28, September 12 and September 25. On October 16, Law Society staff telephoned the member, who said that he would deliver a response the following afternoon but then failed to do so. The member admitted that his conduct in failing unreasonably to respond promptly to Law Society correspondence constituted professional misconduct.
