**Corrigendum of the Hearing Panel**

[1] Counsel have asked me to issue a corrigendum to my report of decision and penalty issued on July 13, 2004. Together they submit that I went further than was intended by the joint submission on penalty when, in paragraph 4, I said that Mr. Geller was required to "...employ a chartered accountant to perform all required accounting work with reference to his practice...". Counsel have pointed out that the issued report differs from my oral pronouncement of the penalty on June 23, 2004 and they are right. Accordingly, the material part of paragraph 4 of the written report should read:

"...I fined the Respondent \$2,000.00 and imposed a condition on his practice, namely, that he direct the chartered accountant he employs for his Form 47 work to report to the Law Society at six month intervals...".

[2] Otherwise, there is no change.
